RoHS / Declaration

The European RoHS Directive 2011/65/UE and the Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 restrict the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

The concerned (10) substances are:

- lead
- mercury
- cadmium
- hexavalent chromium
- polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- N-(Hydroxymethyl)acrylamid (NMA)
- polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)
- di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP)
- butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- dibutylphthalate (DBP)
- diisobutylphthalate (DIBP)

RoHS conformity is covered by the CE marking. For all our products in categories 1 to 11 (in accordance with Annex I of Directive 2011/65/UE), conformity with both directives is included in our CE declarations.

REACH / Declaration

The REACH regulation came into force on 01 June 2007. The aim is to ensure that all substances produced and used in the EU do not have a negative impact on health and the environment.

f-tronic GmbH develops, manufactures and distributes electrotechnical products. No substances are released when our products are used properly. We do not manufacture or import any substances or preparations affected by REACH.

According to REACH, f-tronic is a "downstream user". f-tronic is therefore not subject to any registration obligations and therefore does not have to prepare any safety data sheets.

In line with our commitment to communication along the supply chain, we are in constant contact with both our suppliers and customers.

As a manufacturer of articles within the meaning of REACH, f-tronic also fulfils its responsibility regarding information obligations on SVHC in accordance with Article 33 of the Regulation.

For the SVHC list and in accordance with REACH Article 33, we provide our customers with all information on substances of very high concern in our products if the concentration of more than 0.1% by mass is exceeded.
